• <u>UN Relief & Works Agency (UNRWA)</u> - The largest UN agency in the Mideast, for 70 years providing emergency medical care, humanitarian assistance, food, and education for 1.6 million Palestinian refugees in Gaza, 1.1 million in the West Bank, and more in Jordan, Lebanon, and Syria. At least 232 UNRWA employees in Gaza have died in the conflict – the most UN employees lost in history.
